

## Airport Master Plan

The 1994 Master Plan Update showed the results of a study performed to determine the future aviation needs of the Fayetteville Regional Airport and its service area. The goal of the Master Plan Update was to provide the Fayetteville Airport Commission and the City of Fayetteville with an effective planning tool for guiding future development at the Fayetteville Regional Airport.

After the events of September 11, 2001, the airport's focus for the future has changed, bringing security of the facilities and safety of the passengers to the forefront.

Currently, the Airport Master Plan is being revised, to include additional needs and a redirected focus. Socio-economic data and airport statistical information are being collected by the consulting firm engaged in the Master Plan update.

The document will be available to the public at the FAMPO office upon its completion and a summary will be included in the next update of the Long Range Transportation Plan.
